### We are Making a Difference Together!

#### How We've Helped

• Provided immediate safe and secure homes for 70 youth in our Flexible Solutions emergency placement and respite programs.

• Served 12 teen moms and their babies in our Capable Adolescent Mothers program.

They receive care, clinical treatment, parenting and life skills in a supportive *home-like* setting with their babies.

• Taught Ansell Casey life skills to 186 youth on job readiness, budgeting, personal hygiene, cooking and social skills to our youth in our treatment homes and group home settings.

• Taught communication skills and conflict resolution to 191 middle and high school students in our school-based mentoring programs: Positive Choices, Pre-Teen Promise and our new Camden county based The Young Men of Honor Program.



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**CROSSROADS PROGRAMS**  
Empowering youth who are homeless, abandoned, or at-risk to lead healthy productive lives.

#### WHAT'S NEW

- Awarded funding and installed new generators for 6 group and residential homes so youth can safely shelter in place during a storm and never have to leave their homes!
- Awarded DCF grant to open TWO 5 bed **Stabilization & Assessment Services** programs for youth ages 5 to 12 in Mercer County. Homes will open late 2017 and early 2018.
- Awarded DCF grants to open a 3 group home cluster to serve the I/DD youth population. Homes will open in FY18.

#### WHO WE SERVED

In our corporate year ending August 31, 2017, **CROSSROADS PROGRAMS** provided services to **385 youth and Infants**.

- **95 Youth and 9 Babies** resided in one of our **Transitional Living Group or Residential Treatment Homes**.
- **91 Youth** resided in a **Crossroads Treatment Home** or **host home settings**.
- **190 youth** received **community-based prevention services**.

#### Outcomes

- **85% of youth** in our homes **attended school regularly, had passing grades, and were promoted to the next grade or graduated from school. 81% of our community based youth showed improved school performance.**
- **95% of youth** in our group homes, **showed improvement in their self-sufficiency and life skills.**
- **84% of youth** demonstrated **improvement in behavior.**
- **87% of our youth in treatment homes transitioned positively.**
